She was recruited in 2004 to transform the financial performance of Cleveland Police. By 2007, Cleveland had been described nationally as one of the fastest improving Forces in the country. Today, Cleveland Police is rated as the best police force in England and Wales at dealing with local concerns over policing issues.

In awarding her Finance Director of the Year 2007, the Chair of judges said, “Not only have you transformed the financial performance in a short period, buy you have established your credibility at the highest level by showing a direct correlation between the improvement in finances of the Force and the ability to focus resources on fighting and solving crime, so making Cleveland a safer place to live and work”.

Ann is the first Member of Cleveland Police Staff to have become a Member of the Association of Police Officers (ACPO) and tutors in Financial Management at the National Strategic Command Course. A qualified Chartered Accountant her portfolio includes Finance, Estates, Central Business Unit and she is a Member of the National ACPO Business and Finance Group.
