Terri Teasdale worked with local authorities in Oxfordshire before joining Thames Valley Police in 1973, first as deputy finance officer and then as Force finance officer until 1984. She then moved to the Home Office as financial advisor to Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary and, on leaving the Inspectorate, joined Cranfield Management School as a senior lecturer in accountancy and financial management.

A member of, and former examiner for, the Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountants, Terri was appointed to the post of Director of Resources in 1994.

Terri is responsible for personnel, finance, training and development, transport, procurement and central services and estates management.

In 1997 she was appointed the national representative of police staff on ACPO Cabinet for a two year period. She also is a member of ACPO Finance & Resources Business Area and the ACPO Workforce Development Business Area, and is one of the ACPO reps on the Police Negotiating Board and the Police Advisory Board.

In 1999 Terri was awarded an OBE for her contribution to financial management in the Police Service.
